The Moruya bypass and the Eurobodalla hospital were announced by the government in the lead up to the last state election and since then the community has been trying to obtain the detail behind these promises and understand how they will work together. T4NSW's preferred Bypass route will take ambulances coming from the north 2 kms past the hospital from where they will have to turn back north along the old highway to the hospital site which can only be accessed by turning across traffic travelling south from Moruya. Health Infrastructure NSW and Transport for NSW have supposedly been talking to each other, but they don't seem to be speaking the same language and they aren't listening to the community.

If elected, what will you do to ensure that major infrastructure projects are delivered in a coordinated and strategic way that genuinely involves the community and delivers the best results for the people of this electorate and, more specifically, will you support re-opening the consultation process for the Moruya bypass?
